Admissions Process

Inquire - This is the first step in the admissions process! When you inquire, you will receive a personal phone call from our Head of School. It is a great opportunity for you to get to know us better, ask any questions, and get a feel for our community.

Schedule an In-Person Tour (Required) - During your phone call with the Head of School, you will schedule your tour to see our facility, meet our students and faculty, and learn more about project-based learning. You can also use this <u>LINK</u> to schedule.

Testing (Required) - Please submit scores to recent (within 2 years) academic, psychoeducational, or standardized testing. We accept the following:

- WISC V: Wechsler Intelligence Scale for Children
- CogAT: Cognitive Abilities Test
- WRAT: Wide Ranging Achievement Test
- Woodcock-Johnson IV
- PSAT 8/9
- PSAT NMSQT
- Standford 10 (available online)

Application (Required) - Our <u>application</u> is designed to capture all of the information we'll need to make a decision. You can complete this step as soon as you are ready! Here are the things you'll need to finish your application:

- Student created personal video of 2 minutes or less.
- School Records with current and past grades, attendance, IEP/504 (if applicable)
- Copies of your Cognitive & Achievement testing dated within two years.

Recommender Phone Call (Required) - When completing your application, you will select an individual of your choosing to complete a phone call with our admissions team. Phone calls can be scheduled through our scheduling app, linked <u>HERE</u>. This phone call should only take 5-10 minutes, and you can select anyone who can speak to who you are as a student and person. A suggested list may include Church congregation members, Community Organization Leaders, Neighbors, School Counselors, or Teachers. You should not ask a family member or school-aged friend to complete this phone call on your behalf.

Tuition Assistance Application (Optional) - Tuition Assistance applications found <u>HERE</u>, must be completed at the same time as the admissions application in order to be considered.

Receive Your Admissions Decision

Admissions decisions will be communicated within two weeks of receiving a completed application. We do admit and enroll students on a rolling basis throughout the school year as space permits. **No** decision will be made until ALL application materials are received and processed with the admissions office.
